Ron explained the origin of the now world famous rifle, where it got its name, its

local heritage, why it has been accepted by museums across the world as American Art and why it has been chosen as the Pennsylvania State Rifle.

There were a lot of questions relative to the collecting of the rifle, its identification and its importance to the formation of our country.

Ron pointed out this unique rifle has been accepted worldwide as true American Art and examples are exhibited in New York's Metropolitan Museum of Art.
