3. Technical Section

History of the Mercedes Benz Emblem

As I got closer to drafting the technical article for the NEPA quarterly newsletter, I was having trouble thinking of something interesting to write about. Most of my past articles have been about the origin of Mercedes Benz automobile. I like that theme because it gave me a chance to learn more about Mercedes Benz history. Having just received the current issue of the "Star" magazine, it started me thinking about the origin of the star as the predominate symbol of Mercedes Benz. My quick research of the Mercedes Benz emblem showed that it evolved from a combination of the Mercedes three-pointed star and the Benz laurel wreath emblems. I will supply a little background about each emblem and how they were combined into today's Mercedes Benz emblem. It should be noted that the Mercedes-Benz company is not named after the two people who were the head of the companies that came together to create one of the world's leading luxury car brands. Instead, the name came from the two cars that stood for the two companies, namely Daimler-Motoren-Gesellschaft (DMG) and Benz & Cie.

Benz & Cie Laurel Wreath Emblem

In 1903, the lettering "Original BENZ" surrounded by a black ring gear was used by the Benz & Cie company as a trademark. The heavy technical overtones of the logo reflected the companies' ability in the construction of engines and vehicles.



In 1909, the Mannheim-based company changed this trademark: the name Benz remained as a central element of the logo, but this time it was surrounded by a laurel wreath. This classic decoration awarded to winners of sporting competitions reflects the successes achieved by Benz & Cie in car races during this period.

Benz cars won the "Herkomer Konkurrenz" rally in 1907 and the first "Prinz-Heinrich-Fahrt" (Prince Heinrich Tour) as well as the race from St. Petersburg to Moscow in 1908 among other competitions. In addition to this, Benz achieved second and third places at the French Grand Prix of 1908 and broke three world records at the Daytona Beach meeting in 1909.

From 1909, this outstanding record of achievement was depicted in a decorated

trademark whose typographic content had now been reduced to four dynamically written letters: "Benz". The name of the Mannheim-based brand was synonymous with originality in 1909, even without an express reference in the trademark.

Mercedes Star Emblem

The 1901 Mercedes was manufactured by Daimler-Motoren-Gesellschaft or DMG. The car was part of a series of cars that were built for an Austrian diplomat named Emil Jellinek. Emil was also a racing enthusiast who managed to increase the consumer's interest in DMG cars by using them in the car races he took part in. This resulted in Jellinek being a part of DMG's leadership and the name of his car, the Mercedes, was associated with a series of cars that he took part in creating.



Mercedes was the pet name of Jellinek's daughter Adrienne. Between 1902 and 1909, the logo simple read "Mercedes" in a Ford-like oval shape.

1909 was the year when Mercedes Saw the creation of their iconic three-pointed star logo design.



The original Mercedes logo was the brainchild of Gottlieb Daimler's sons, Adolf, and Paul. It was created by Gottlieb who drew the design on a postcard that he was going to send his wife.

When he pitched his idea, he said that this logo would be the most famous corporate identity in the coming years. Originally, it was not encased in a circle, as it depicted the three modes of transport, land, sea, and air



Mercedes introduced a new emblem in 1916. It featured a three-point star that was surrounded by a circle, has four small stars and the name of the company. The emblem remained Mercedes brand identity for ten years.

Mercedes Benz Emblem

In 1926, a laurel wreath was added to the design to incorporate the brand identities of both businesses. The wreath was once a part of the Benz & Cie motors emblem, and when they merged with Daimler-Benz AG, the decision was made to add the wreaths. This formed a new logo that included the names of both companies:

Mercedes and Benz & Cie.



The logo remained in its original blue color and the badge that is standing at the radiator was changed to silver in 2008. The silver color has been associated with Mercedes ever since it joined in the first Grand Prix in 1934. During that same year, Mercedes-Benz produced racing cars which they called the "Silver Arrows." The series became famous for their silver color which later became the primary color of the famous automobile company.

The famous three-pointed star logo still stands for the corporate identity of Mercedes-Benz until today and it is used with color variations in various products of Mercedes-Benz

Our destination on this drive was the National Centre for Padre Pio, Barto, Pennsylvania. We began at Dunken Donuts in Foglesville and wended our way over backroads and saw some of the beautiful Pennsylvania and other interesting sites along the way.

Barry, one of the two architects that went to Rome and brought that Padre Pio shrine design back to Barto, provided our group with some of the back stories on the design and development of this Centre. It was very interesting and at times humorous. Thank you, Barry!

A little of the history of the Shrine: Padre Pio lived from 1887 to 1968, was afflicted with the "stigmata," open wounds on the hands as suffered by Jesus when he was crucified. Padre Pio was canonized in June of 2002 by Pope John Paul II and the Centre held masses, talks and showed a live broadcast of the ceremony at the Vatican.

Vera Marie Calandra, of Norristown, was born with severe congenital defects and her doctors gave up hope that she would survive. But in 1968, her mother took the two-year-old girl to Italy to see Padre Pio, a Franciscan Capuchin monk believed by his followers to have healing powers. He touched her on the head twice and within days, the family said, she began to grow a new bladder. Today, Vera Marie helps to manage the Centre and Padre Pio, the man they say saved her, has become a saint.

The Calandra family made a commitment to let the people know the good and caring person Padre Pio was. To carry out this promise, the Calandra family founded the Padre Pio center and, using donations, built a \$3 million Italian chapel and a museum on more than 100 acres of land in Barto, Pennsylvania.

MBCA 2022 MOUNTAIN VIEW RALLY

Saturday October first, 2022 was the date scheduled for our popular Fall Mercedes Club Rally. A record number of cars and participants had signed up planning to attend. Then came hurricane Ian. The storm set its sights on Fort Myers Beach Florida September 28th hitting Florida with the strongest storms ever to hit the United States. Causing tremendous damage, the storm left Florida setting its sights on Charleston South Carolina Friday September 30th. Local weather forecasts were forecasting rain in our area beginning on Friday night before our rally and lasting through the entire day of the rally. What should we do? We decided, for those willing to risk it, to meet for breakfast in the morning, see how many would show up and what the weather had to offer, then either run the rally or go home. Well, never underestimate our members, six cars and twelve participants showed up. It did rain the night before, but by the time breakfast was over the day cleared up, we ran the rally, and it was a huge success. We held our 2022 Fall 30.1 mile Rally with Six cars and twelve members participating plus the rally master and his wife.

First place went to car #2, Otto Christensen & Wesley Wormser, with a score of 175.0 out of a possible 200, close behind in second places were car #6, Michele & Arlene Frailey, and in third place car #1, Mike & Nancy Ziegler. Second and third place each had scores of 173.0 out of 200, the tie being broken by the answer to an extra credit question.



Tom Masano Inc.-Reading, PA Hosts a Mercedes Benz Technical Session



The morning started off with a presentation by Phil Hart of the new all-electric EQS Mercedes-Benz. Phil talked about its unique features and gave an all-inclusive tour of this amazing vehicle. We also toured the service drive-through and discussed the electric charging options that are available for the Mercedes Benz EV. We talked about the different electric service voltages that can be used for slow and quick charging, and recommendations for homecharging stations.

We next met with Steve Bare, the Service Advisor and Mark Zimmerman, the Lead Technician who answered service and technical questions to NEPA section members about their personal Mercedes Benz cars. The Lead Technicians' answers were informative and generated information about what is involved with the inspection and service of a Mercedes Benz. Masano Mercedes Benz also arranged for test drives of the EQS hatchback.

Airbag Recall

At Mercedes-Benz, our highest priority is keeping you safe. So we'd like to share some important information about a recall involving Takata frontal airbags used in many vehicles, including certain Mercedes-Benz models. This safety recall is a result of inflators that may improperly deploy with excessive force in the event of a crash. Takata and other inflator suppliers are working with the U.S. Department of Transportation National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) to coordinate availability of replacement airbags as soon as possible. 
