"NEPA 2024 Summer Tech Session" Schearer's European Automotive Specialists

Saturday, July 27th

The Northeast PA (NEPA) section of the Mercedes Benz Club of America (MBCA) held its 2024 summer technical session at <u>Schearer's European Automotive Specialists</u> located at 5530 Crackersport Rd, Allentown, PA 18104. Samantha Schearer, the business' service advisor, hosted the event. Coffee and donuts were provided by Schearer's.

Tom Schearer's Mercedes Mechanic Jeff Deitz introduced the staff that specializes in Mercedes Benz service and repairs. Tom keeps the shop fully equipped with the latest factory-grade tools & equipment available to manage everything your car needs.

Jeff and his staff went over some basic principles of diagnosing problems, focusing on what is "safe" for owners to do and when to get a professional involved. For example, if you are a DIY mechanic with a code scanner, do not erase the error codes before you have diagnosed and fixed the problem. You may need expert help, and they will need to see all the error codes to help. DIY is not always the best choice when you have a severe problem.

The first Mercedes brought in was Roger Egolf's 2003 SL500. Rick showed how the diagnostic tool worked as well as some very convenient features, such as being able to tilt the car forward and down and backward and up to give better access when performing various services.

The session took off from its original course and put several owners' MB's up on lifts and showed us the undercarriages as well as helping to diagnose some 'noises' some owners heard on the roads.

We were also given maintenance recommendations from an independent repair facility point of view to give tips on making our Mercedes Benz last longer than the 100K miles the manufacturer wants them to. Waiting for problems to occur is not a good maintenance strategy. We were also educated on warning signs to look for to reduce breakdowns and catastrophic failures.

Following the tech session, some members went on a 'mini' day drive from Schearer's to lunch at

Thanks to Jay Hirsch for providing us excellent pictures from the event, the attendees and our cars!


















New Hope Auto Show Sunday, August 11 (Foreign Cars) 9AM - 4PM

7. MBCA website system change, attention members who were on automatic membership renewal:

MBCA's website www.mbca.org host has changed (old system will soon no longer be supported, so MBCA had to find a new system). Therefore, all the credit card numbers that were in the old system have been deleted and are not in the new system. If you are not able to log on the website to renew online, you will have to renew by calling MBCA National at 719-633-6427 (note: the 800# is no longer in service). Renewing with your credit card will incur a 3.75% credit card processing fee. You may send a check to National to avoid the fee. Your member number also changed with the new system. The new system is a work in progress, please be patient while the bugs are being worked out.

8. Past Items of Interest

Airbag Recall

At Mercedes-Benz, our highest priority is keeping you safe. So we'd like to share some important information about a recall involving Takata frontal airbags used in many vehicles, including certain Mercedes-Benz models. This safety recall is a result of inflators that may improperly deploy with excessive force in the event of a crash. Takata and other inflator suppliers are working with the U.S. Department of Transportation National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) to coordinate availability of replacement airbags as soon as possible. To learn more about the Takata Recall, including information on free airbag replacement, visit mbusa.com/mercedes/recall.

Personalized License Plates now Available from DMV

The Pennsylvania license plates with the Mercedes-Benz Club of America logo on them were available through our Keystone Section. They are available either sequence numbered, or customized with up to 5 letter/numbers for an additional one-time fee. MBCA Car Flags

Blue car flags with the MBCA logo on both sides are available. They fit on the side windows. They are good for any MBCA event to show your support of our club. They are available from Debbie Egolf or Mike Ziegler at most events. Preferably, email Debbie at egolf2000@yahoo.com so she knows to give it to you at the event you are going to. There is a donation of \$5 requested preferably by check to MBCA-NEPA. Get one for each of your MB cars and keep it in the car, so you don't have to remember to take it with you on an event.

Name Badges:

Please wear your name badge to all events. If you (a NEPA member or associate member) never got a badge, your NEPA section will pay \$10 and you pay the other \$10 and it will be sent to you in the mail. Payment (cash or check) must be paid before nametags are ordered. Three lines are

permitted: 1st line is for your first and last name (what you want fellow members to call you should be your first name), 2nd line is our section name, and optional 3rd line to list your car or other item. Member name badges are blue (gold for officers, silver for directors). You may get a magnetic clip (most popular), dual tie tack clips, or a pin type.

If you lost your badge or would like one to keep in your other MB, they are \$20. Order your additional nametag or replacement nametag directly by going to www.mbca.org, then login, then click "Store", then click "VIEW MBCA EVENT EQUIPMENT STORE".


